COSTUME GUIDELINES

- 1.) Costumes need to be simple. Think of your favorite tv character, book character, animal, famous person, etc.!
- 2.) No weapons, weapon look a likes, or violent costumes (no pretend blood etc.)
- 3.) Students must be able to put their costume on over their school clothes in the afternoon with minimal help.
- 4.) Students should bring their costume/accessories in a garbage bag labeled with their name/homeroom teacher.
- 5.) Costumes made out of boxes or other larger items should be brought to school by the parent/guardian. These items are not to be taken on the school bus.
- 6.) AGAIN--- No weapons, weapon look alike, violent costumes, pretend blood, or sharp objects are to accompany costumes.

We ask for your cooperation in following these guidelines so we can make this an annual event!

PARENT VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES

- 1.) Volunteers who are asked to assist with the Fall Fest Party may arrive any time after 2:00 pm, and they must sign-in and out at the front office.
- 2.) Staff will be providing a list of 2 to 3 volunteers who will be helping out with the classroom or grade-level party. Only those individuals whose names are on the list, will be permitted to go back to the classrooms.
